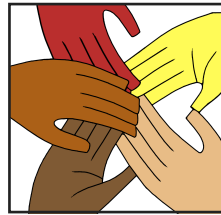

We have an active healing prayer ministry and will begin offering a monthly hour of healing prayer on the first Sunday of each month from 1pm -2pm at our church. This Healing Prayer Service on April 8th, will be the initiation of these monthly prayer hours which will begin on May 4.

All are welcome! We hope you will come and share our first Healing Prayer Service with us. We invite you to attend and receive prayer for yourself, or for someone else you are praying for who may not be able to be present.

HEALING PRAYER

Acting as an intercessor, we offer loving support and comfort to those in need while keeping them connected to the Church Family. As there are varying levels and degrees of need, our ministry serves with healing prayers, sending cards to offer compassion, delivery of a blessed prayer shawl or cap, laying on of hands, and anointing with oil. The Healing Prayer Ministry at St. Philip Neri Ecumenical Church prays with members of our Church family whenever there is a request. Most often, this takes place after our service on Sunday. An Hour of Healing Prayer is held on the last Tuesday of each month from 7-8 pm at Church. We open with a short scripture reading followed by 20-minute prayer with 2 trained ministers.

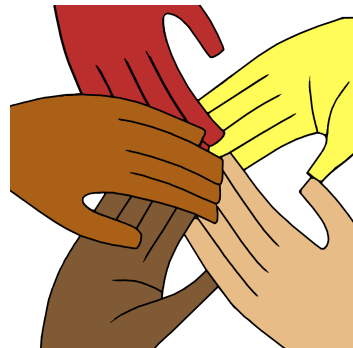

PRAYER SHAWL PRAYER CAP

When those in need of healing prayer cannot be physically present to us, we offer a prayer shawl or prayer cap to them as an outward sign of faith in God's healing power. A prayer shawl/cap is a soft and luxurious garment held in the hands of those intercessors who anoint this textile with blessings and healing energy. We ask for God's guidance to help us know how to pray more specifically and effectively for the love-one's individual healing. We ask the Holy Spirit to carry our love, presence, and prayers to the recipient in hopes that the shawl/cap helps to comfort and serve as a physical reminder that the person is not alone in prayer, while we continue to pray for their healing.
